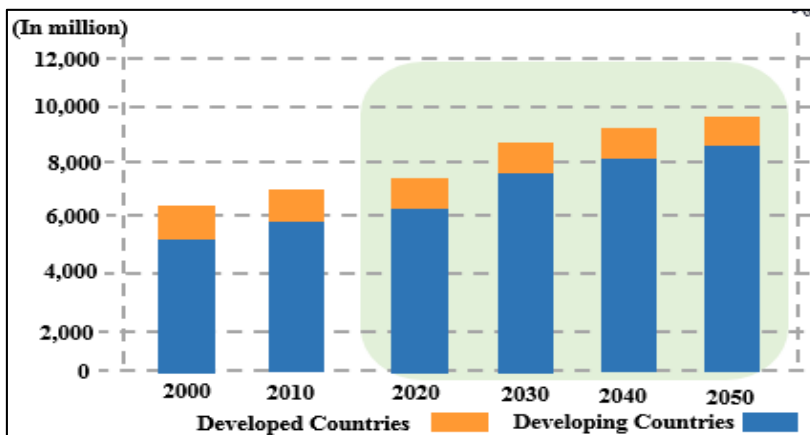

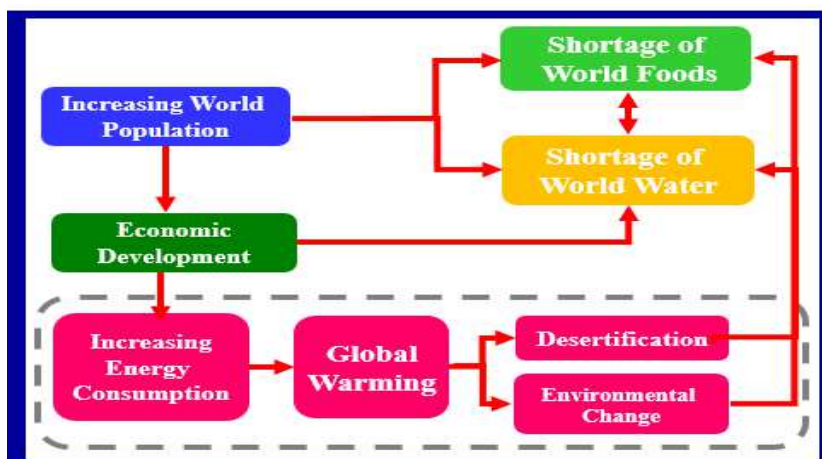
[Increasing World Population]
